### **Call for Abstracts**

We invite you to submit your abstracts for inclusion in the Parkinson's Disease 200: Back to the Future Conference, which will be held within the Royal college of Physicians of Edinburgh on Thursday 21 September 2017 & Friday 22 September 2017. The presentation and poster session will be on **Thursday 21 September 2017**.

Abstracts should relate to Parkinson's disease, e.g. clinical, pathology, basic science, epidemiology, psychology, physiotherapy and occupational therapy.

**Oral Presentations:** 4 papers will be selected to present their findings orally. The winning presenter will receive the Parkinson's Disease 200 Medal and £200

Abstracts should provide a clear outline of the work, relevant background, any research results and/or evaluation findings to date and relevant conclusions.

- Abstract submission length: Maximum 250 words (excluding max. 3-4 references)
- Presentation time: 15 minutes (10 minutes for presentation & 5 minutes for discussion and/or questions)

**Posters:** will be made available for viewing on **Thursday 21 September**. Successful posters will have an opportunity to discuss their findings with the Scientific Advisory Committee within the poster viewing session.

**Deadline:** All submissions will be reviewed by the Scientific Advisory Committee and the deadline is **midnight on Sunday 28 May 2017**, those selected for oral & poster presentation will be informed by mid-June 2017.

**Delegates:** All those invited for oral & poster presentation will register to attend the conference as a delegate. Online registration is available.
