Call for Abstracts: Clinical Lessons Prize & Poster Session

### **Clinical Lessons Prize**

Abstracts are invited from Collegiate Members, Associates & Medical Students and Foundation Year Members of any of the UK Royal Colleges for the Clinical Lessons sessions at our symposium planned for January 2020. A prize will be awarded for the best Collegiate Member/Associate presentation and also a prize for the best Student/Foundation Year Member presentation. Those who have been chosen to present will deliver their talk at **ETC Venue, 11 Portland Street, Manchester, M1 3HU**. Cases should be relevant to a general medical audience and should carry a clear lesson.

The format is strictly 8 minutes for presentation and 2 minutes for questions. Presentations should be in MS Powerpoint format, and should not contain too many slides for the allotted time.

### **Poster Session Prize**

Those abstracts that are not selected for oral presentation will be put forward for presentation at our poster session and a prize will be awarded for best poster at our event.

Abstracts should be submitted to [a.fairbairn@rcpe.ac.uk](mailto:a.fairbairn@rcpe.ac.uk) NO LATER THAN MIDNIGHT GMT ON MONDAY 9 December 2019. Abstracts will be accepted as Word or pdf attachments, or within the body of the email text, in the following format:

1. **Presentation Title:** *(Note: The title, in the first slide, should be sufficiently cryptic to prevent the audience from immediately knowing the case's content)*
2. **Presenting Author:** *(Please give your last name or the name by which you wish to be known in capitals (e.g. Dr John SMITH, Dr Abdul MOHAMMED Hussein))*

3. **Contact details of Presenting Author:**

Primary e-mail address

4. **Student & Foundation Members** – contact details of senior sponsor involved in the case: Name + Position of senior sponsor (e.g. Consultant Gastroenterologist or SpR/ST Rheumatology). The name of the hospital your senior sponsor works at.
5. **Body of Abstract** (*MUST NOT EXCEED 200 WORDS*). *This should give brief details of the case, state clearly the lesson to be presented and state what illustrations will be used e.g. CXR, ECG, histology, clinical photographs etc.*
6. **Travel expenses:** *Those who are invited to present at the symposium should approach their Deanery for study leave and travel expenses.*
